We provide full-day, year-round educational, behavioral, medical, and rehabilitative services, and use established treatment and educational methods based on the latest instructional, clinical, and applied behavior analytic research.

School services may be combined with an on-campus or community-based residential program at one of our on-campus residences or several homes in nearby neighborhoods.
